


Launching SoP Result

LAUNCHING THE STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF HIV/AIDS PREVENTION, CARE, AND TREATMENT IN CLOSED SETTING AND TRAINING ON HIV AND ARV TO HEALTH POST OFFICERS IN CLOSED SETTING

November 15-17, 2022 | Provincial Health Department Meeting Room | Kampong Cham Province.



A one day launching standard operation procedures for implementation of HIV/AIDS prevention, care, and treatment in closed setting and two-day training on HIV and ARV to health post officers in closed setting conducted by NCHADS in partnership with CRS and NGO Partner took place on November 15-17, 2022, at provincial health department meeting room, Kampong Cham province. The objective launching was to (1) launch on SoP support for the implementation of HIV/AIDS prevention, care, and treatment in closed settings, (2) train on SoP support for the implementation of prevention, care, and treatment of HIV/AIDS, in closed settings, (3) improve and strengthen access to high-quality of HIV, STI, and HIV/TB prevention,

care, treatment and support service for those who live in closed settings and (4) enhance and strengthen referral mechanism for HIV-related services in closed settings and re-engagement after discharge.

A total of 68 participants from 25 provinces and Phnom Penh attended the launching workshop, including 29 closed setting (4 Correctional Center and 25 Provincial Prison, NCHADS management and all relevant units, PHD, PASP, AUA, KWWA, CPN+, PC, EpiC project of the FHI360, and Caritas Cambodia,



The launching started with the remarks from Dr. Men Bunnan, Deputy Director of Kampong Cham PHD, remarks from Mr. Arthur Kirby, Country Representative for Cambodia and Vietnam, remarks by Dr. Ouk Vichea, Director of NCHADS, remarks by H.E. Lim Sokha, Deputy Director General of Directorate General of Prison and opening remark by H.E. Dr Lon Chanrasmey, Deputy Director General for Health, Project Manager for Technical of MoH-LIT, and Deputy Inter-Ministerial in Prison Technical Working Group who presided over the workshop. H.E Lon Chanrasmey opened this launching and training in the name of H.E Hok Kimcheng, Director

General for Health, MoH.

There is three main presentation topics presented at the workshop, 1) Cambodia's HIV/AIDS situation and response by Dr Ngau Bora, Deputy Director of NCHADS, 2) HIV/AIDS prevalence in Cambodian prisons by Dr. Chengli Bunty Chief of Health Office for Department of Correction Center and Rehabilitation , and (3) overview of the standard operating procedures for the delivery of HIV/AIDS prevention, care, and treatment in closed settings and basic service packages including open the floor question and discussion by Dr. Chengli Bunty, GDP of Ministry of Interior and Mr. Sorng Sophat, CRS Senior Project Coordinator.

The Standard Operating Procedures for Implementation of HIV/AIDS Prevention, Care, and Treatment in Closed Settings were officially launched to celebrate the tremendous collective achievement of NCHADS, GDP, and CRS, along with other partners.
