

REGIONAL WORKSHOP TO REVIEW THE RESULTS OF INTERLINK ACTIVE CASE MANAGEMENT AND CONTINUES QUALITY IMPROVEMENT (IACM-CQI)

November 17-18, 2022 | Provincial Health Department Meeting Room | Kampong Chhnang Province.

The regional workshop started with the remarks from Dr. Chan Sodara, representative of US CDC, Dr. Ngauv Bora, deputy director of NCHADS and Dr. Dr. Lem Leangngoun, deputy director of Kampong Chhnang PHD. Dr. Lem Leangngoun opened the regional workshop on IACM-CQI on behalf of H.E PHD director of Kampong Chhnang.

The regional review workshop to review the results of interlink active case management and continues quality improvement (IACM-CQI) organized by NCHADS under funding supported by US-CDC is quarterly regional workshop with the presence of Provincial AIDS and STI Program (PASP) managers, ART team leaders and provincial data management officers from 12 ART sites of 7 provinces, Kandal, Kampong Spue, Takeo, Pursat, Kampot, Pailin, Koh Kong and Kampong Chhnang. This regional workshop is one of the important events of NCHADS for reviewing and reflection the main activities/indicators of care and treatment to PLHIV of each ART site in each province and finding the root cause/solution and making the plan for improving the quality of care and treatment in ART sites to achieve the national goal 95-95-95 in 2025.

The objective of the 2 day-workshop is to following review, analyzed barriers root causes, making the next plan for fixing/solution, and improving the quality of care and treatment in ART sites mainly the following clinical indicators:

- 1- % ART patient died
- 2- % ART patient missed appointment date ≤ 28 days and > 28 days returned to ART service.
- 3- % ART patient visited ART service on the appointment date
- 4- % new patient started ARV the same day of the day HIV diagnosed in the quarter
- 5- % of ART patients eligible for VL testing in the quarter have done VL test
- 6- % VL result returning to ART site within the 14 days
- 7- % ART patients have VL suppressed
- 8- % of PLHIV on ART at least 6 months have VL tests done at least one time during the last 12 month
- 9- # and % of patients have completed TPT course up to September 2022
- 10- # and % of patients on ART have appointment spaces ≥ 3 months up to September 2022
- 11- % of new patient initiated TLD
- 12- % of total ART patients received TLD up to September 2022
- 13- Retention rate of patients are staying in the ART services (Retention rate)
