REGIONAL WORKSHOP TO REVIEW THE RESULTS OF INTERLINK ACTIVE CASE MANAGEMENT AND CONTINUES QUALITY IMPROVEMENT (IACM-CQI)

The regional workshop started with the remarks from Dr. Prak Narom, representative of NCHADS and opened remark of the regional workshop on IACM-CQI by Dr. Seng Sopharun, Deputy Director of Kampong Cham Provincial Health Department (PHD).

The regional review workshop aimed to review the results of interlink active case management and continues quality improvement (IACM-CQI) organized by NCHADS under funding supported by US-CDC. The quarterly regional workshop with the presence of Provincial AIDS and STI Program (PASP) managers, ART team leaders and provincial data management officers from 7 ART sites of 7 provinces, Kratie, Stueng Treng, Tboung Khmum, Prey Veng, Svay Rieng Kampong Thom and Kampong Chhnang. This regional workshop is one of the important events of NCHADS as the mirror to reflex the activities have done in care and treatment to PLIHV by ART sites in the past quarter of each province based on the national CQI indicators.

The main objective of the 2 day-workshop is to following review, analyzed the rout causes, barriers of each indicator that was low performance or not achieved the target and making the next plan for improving by ART team leader/PASAP. Below are the clinically indicators:

- 1- % of ART patient died
- 2- % of ART patient missed appointment date ≤28 days and >28 days returned to ART service.
- 3- % of ART patient visited ART service on the appointment date
- 4- % of new patient started ARV the same day of the day HIV diagnosed in the quarter
- 5- % of ART patients eligible for VL testing in the quarter have done VL test
- 6- % of VL result returning to ART site within the 14 days
- 7- % ART patients have VL suppressed
- 8- % of PLHIV on ART at least 6 months have VL tests done at least one time during the last 12 month
- 9- # and % of patients have completed TPT course up to September 2022
- 10- # and % of patients on ART have appointment spaces ≥3 months up to September 2022
- 11- % of new patient initiated TLD
- 12- % of total ART patients received TLD up to September 2022
- 13- Retention rate of patients are staying in the ART services (Retention rate)
