

Training on Data Use in the NPD System for Boosted Continuum of Prevention to Care and Treatment (B-CoPCT)

The two-day training on prevention data-use to better targeted prevention testing program was organized by the Behavior Change Communication (BCC) and Data Management Unit (DMU) of NCHADS with financial and technical support from EpiC project of FHI360 on March 06–07, 2023 at Meeting Room in Provincial Health Department, Kampong Cham Province. Two main goals of the training were to improve capacity of key staffs of provincial HIV and STI program (PASP) and community-based organizations on the using of key population (KP) prevention data generating from the National Prevention Database (NPD) system to improve HIV prevention program for KP in line with the Boosted Continuum of Prevention to Care and Treatment (B-CoPCT) standard operating procedure.

Key topics of the data use training were:

- Updated status of Prevention Intervention among KPs through HIV cascade (HIV testing/ yield of HIV by KPs, by modality, by provinces and by hotspots positive)
- Integrated GBV into data collecting forms (form 1 :Provide education/HIV Test, and form 2:Referral) and in the DHIS2 of NPD System.
- Online Reservation Application (ORA) and Virtual outreach/SBCC implementation and data
- Updated status of PrEP implementation and data.
- Data analysis and visualization: Data visualizer Tools both on smartphone and laptop for national indicators like HIV Prevention, GIS Mapping, HIVST and PDI+ network visualizing, GIS Mapping visualizing and routine plan to update.
- Effective data use to drive program improvement.

The training applied adult learning approach and provided an opportunity for participant to engage and share their experience. Majority of the participants expressed their interest in most of the topics and appreciate NCAHDS and EpiC for such a great training session. Participants commit to apply the skill they learnt to improve data use for better program implementation at sub-national level. DMU team will follow up with each of the province to ensure they are using and discussing prevention data every quarter.
