

Cambodia Sub-national HIV Estimates Workshop

June 26-29, 2023

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) and UNAIDS is organizing an important workshop on HIV estimates for sub-national level in Cambodia. The objectives of this workshop are to discuss methodologies of sub-national estimates with TWG and stakeholders, review and discuss data inputs for sub-national estimates, update sub-national spectrum files, review and validate results and document data assumption, adjustments, and data triangulation for the sub-national estimates. The expected output of this workshop are to have sub-national spectrum files for 25 provinces updated with most up-to-date data inputs as agreed by technical working group (TWG) and the data assumption, adjustments, and data triangulation are systematically documented and shared with TWG.



This workshop is running in hybrid mode (in-person and online) with the technical support from Dr Wiwat Peerapatanapokin (EWC) and Dr Khin Cho Win Htin (UNAIDS) and core working group such as NCHADS-DMU, UNAIDS, EpiC-FHI360, NMCHC and other stakeholders.

The workshop is started from the introduction and informative remark from Dr. Patricia Ungpin, country director of UNAIDS, and official opening announcement from Dr. Ouk Vichea, Director of NCHADS, and followed by technical session for generating the result of HIV estimates for sub-national level in Cambodia.
